

Position Words (Prepositions) in a Fall Scene

Grade: 3-5 | Subject: English | Week 10: The Four Seasons and How They Change | Time: 35–45 minutes

Learning Objective

Student will independently use at least 5 position words (prepositions) to describe where objects are located in a seasonal scene.

Materials Needed

A large drawn or printed fall scene (tree, sky, ground, squirrel, nest), small movable cutouts (leaf, bird, acorn), preposition word cards (on, under, above, in, next to)

Practice Activity

Child arranges 3 cutouts on the scene independently and describes each placement aloud using a complete sentence with a preposition. Extend by writing 2-3 sentences reflecting on the skill.
