

Composing 2D Shapes to Build a Habitat Scene

Grade: 3-5 | Subject: Math | Week 19: Animals and Their Habitats | Time: 35–45 minutes

Learning Objective

Student will independently compose a simple habitat picture using at least 4 different 2D shapes.

Materials Needed

2D shape cutouts (circles, triangles, squares, rectangles, ovals), glue stick, paper, crayons

Practice Activity

Child names each shape used in their picture and counts how many total shapes they used. Extend by writing 2-3 sentences reflecting on the skill.
